#### **Mission Statement:**

People in developing countries are often dependent on donors for more than money – they frequently rely on donors to identify and solve their problems. Participate Now, Inc aims to empower people to become active participants rather than just recipients, attain self respect and dignity that are so necessary for all human beings. This is accomplished by providing financial education and small business training to help people gain marketable skills to be able to provide for themselves and their families. This will be done by living amongst the people, listening and learning to what is needed, providing assistance to getting those needs met. We will be working to build on existing economic and social systems rather than introducing new ones, inspiring and influencing to affect change that is effective, efficient and sustainable while raising the quality of life for those who are often disadvantaged.

#### **Operating Values:**

- Provide basic training to develop business management skills and leadership qualities
- Focus on small scale projects to attain the highest rate of success – break the projects into modules to be chronicled, measured and replicated
- Monitor donor funds closely for effectiveness and efficiency
- Conduct pilot projects as learning exercises and use that knowledge to further development
- Share project result information with participants to utilize results as a best practice to continue to build on the successes and learn from mistakes to deepen problem solving skills
- Build relationships between local people, organizations and international donors to ensure sustainability

- Provide people with the resources to recognize business opportunities and to develop and capitalize on their own ideas and innovations.

**How to carry this out:**

- Assist in developing and monitoring rural water and conservation projects
- Assist in developing and mentoring a private sector teaching farm for nutrition training
- Promote local business links, expertise, and communication through small business trainings, workshops, and mentoring
- Provide micro-finance training, facilitation, monitoring, and supervision in order to promote sustainable growth and business capacity
- Empower individuals with HIV/AIDS to attain self-respect and dignity by providing these individuals with access to existing economic and social systems

I have been an integral part of many positive initiatives here in Zanzibar in the past three years and I would like your help and support to continue my work. Below are some of my photos of living results.
